SUMMIT SCHOOL

As part of an overall masterplan to expand and reorganize the Summit School Campus in Edgewater, BWH collaborated closely with the school's Building Committee to develop conceptual building and site layouts. This endeavor encompassed the demolition of a 1940's barn structure and the construction of a new 30,000 square foot "Upper School" facility tailored to accommodate grades 6 through 8, alongside administrative offices, and a testing & tutoring center. Notably, the building was designed to be connected to the existing Main School Building for seamless integration.

In addition to focusing on the educational needs, a heightened level of school security measures was integrated into both the building design and site layout, underscoring a commitment to fostering a safe and conducive learning environment. Moreover, the project entailed the reconfiguration of sports fields to accommodate a regulation-sized soccer field and ample parking to allow the fields to be rented for competitive play.

SEVERN SCHOOL

BWH served as the Owners Representative for The Severn School during the design and construction of the Teel Academic Center. This three-story academic building was strategically designed to integrate with two existing structures, forming a cohesive complex. The project necessitated the removal of an existing building and the installation of temporary classroom structures. Our responsibilities included reviewing the architects design, facilitating construction coordination with staff, conducting progress meetings, and promptly reporting any issues to the Head of School.







UNITED STATES NAVAL ACADEMY LACROSSE CENTER

BWH is currently designing the Lacrosse Center for the U.S. Naval Academy Athletic Association. This facility will be constructed on the grounds of the Naval Academy along the shore of the Severn River in Annapolis, Maryland.

This 33,000 square-foot athletic center will contain a weight room and fitness gym, sports locker rooms, snack areas, medical training rooms, coaching offices, and a theater for film studies. To meet the needs of the Academy while also meeting the square foot limitation, our team is designing the building with efficiency and functionality in mind. When prospective athletes visit, the design will also serve as a recruitment tool for the Naval Academy, which requires 5 years of military service from all students.

Upon entering the center, visitors will be invited to view the achievements of the alumni, for whom the building is being named after. The natural light of the central atrium will draw visitors in to learn about the glory of the US Navy, the history of the US Naval Academy, and the success of their lacrosse program to date. Among the many details designed to immerse and inspire visitors are award exhibits, video displays, historic profiles, graphics, photographs, and 3D images.
