PRINCE FREDERICK VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT STATION NO. 2

BWH designed this high value/low maintenance state-of-the-art station for Prince Frederick Volunteer Fire Company. This 30,000 sf. facility includes five drive-thru apparatus bays plus a wash bay. The living and administration areas contain office space, bunkrooms, kitchen/dining space, training room and support space to accommodate shift personnel. A museum area and meeting spaces are open to the public. The facility is designed to adhere to the "hot zone" concept of separating contaminated areas from clean living spaces.







WATERLOO FIRE STATION

BWH worked on this LEED Gold Certified project with Howard County throughout its evolution over several years. In 2019, a deal was made with the State to purchase the land for \$1, allowing the County to pay for infrastructure to reduce future flood waters in Ellicott City.

With the goal of LEED Gold Certification, the focus for the new 15,000 sf. fire station design was cost effeciency and energy efficency. A size reduction allowed for the station to be built initially with three apparatus bays and the ability to add a fourth bay in the future. A county police suite was placed within the facility.

Working with the county, our firm developed design standards in response to the COVID-19 pandemic and incorporated these standards into the station. A transition corridor has been added off the apparatus bay to allow for cleaning and disinfecting of personnel before entering the living areas. Emphasis is being placed on the treatment and movement of the air within the bunkrooms, which are gender-neutral.
